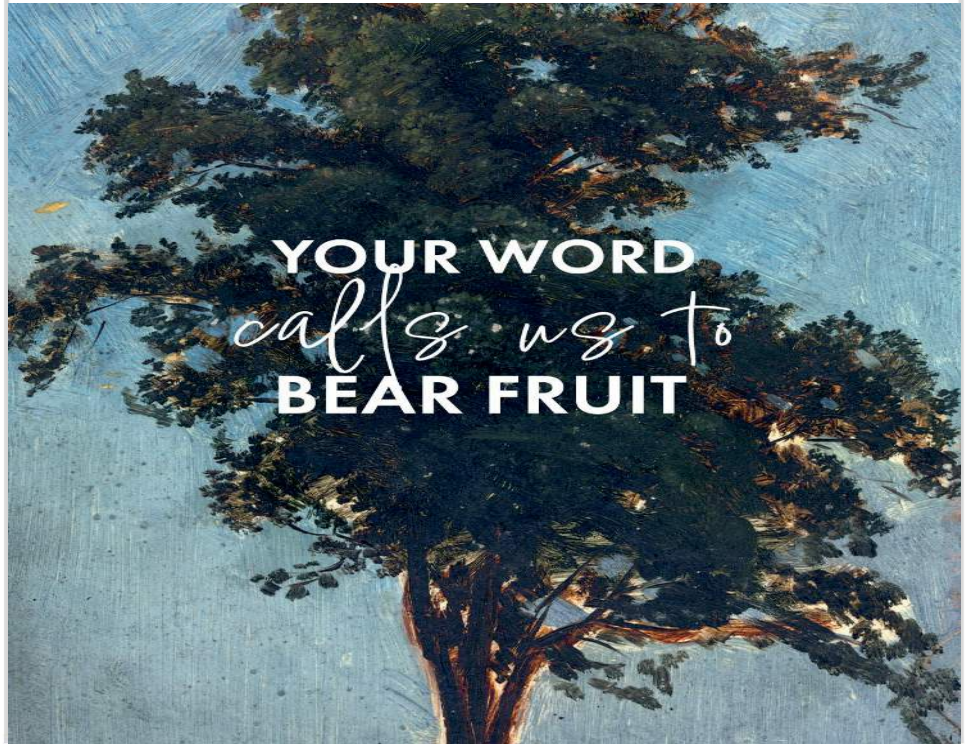

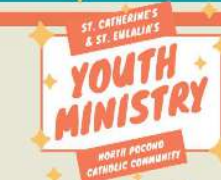

Both parishes continue to be vibrant signs of hope within the Diocese, welcoming young families and fostering strong faith communities. In 2025, Saint Eulalia Parish celebrated 30 baptisms and Saint Catherine of Siena Parish celebrated 33 baptisms. Together, the parishes also serve nearly 500 children in religious education programs, among the largest enrollments in the Diocese of Scranton.
