As part of the Diocese of Scranton’s Vision 2030 Pastoral Planning Process, Saint Catherine of Siena Parish, Moscow and Saint Eulalia Parish, Roaring Brook Township, will enter into a parish linkage effective **July 15, 2026**.

While remaining independent parishes, they will share one pastor and work cooperatively in ministry, programming, and parish life.

Bishop Bambera has appointed Father Thomas M. Muldowney as Pastor of the new linkage effective July 15, 2026. Father Muldowney has faithfully served Saint Catherine of Siena Parish with dedication and pastoral care, and the Diocese is confident he will lead both parish communities with wisdom, compassion and a collaborative spirit.

Both parishes continue to be vibrant signs of hope within the Diocese, welcoming young families and fostering strong faith communities. In 2025, Saint Eulalia Parish celebrated 30 baptisms and Saint Catherine of Siena Parish celebrated 33 baptisms. Together, the parishes also serve nearly 500 children in religious education programs, among the largest enrollments in the Diocese of Scranton.
