This Week's Family Reflection for the 20th Week of Ordinary Time —

Gospel Reading—Luke 12:49-53

Jesus has come not only to bring peace but also division.

Families strive for unity and togetherness. Nobody enjoys occasions when divisions in family life arise. Yet, in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says that he has come to bring division and that members of households will be divided.

Talk as a family about the things that you do together to bring about family unity, such as sharing meals, going to Mass, celebrating special occasions, or sharing family traditions. Explain that all of these things are important and that Jesus wants families to show this kind of love for one another. Point out that this Sunday's Gospel sounds as though Jesus is saying something very different. Tell your children to listen closely as you read aloud Luke 12:49-53.

Explain that sometimes as parents, you have to make decisions that are unpopular with your children. In the short run, such decisions may "divide" children from their parents. In the long run, however, doing the right thing will bring about a deeper unity.
